Aim of the Workshop

As nurses, we work with many patients who will eventually lose their life, even with improving cure rates. Historically, nursing curriculums have been woefully inadequate at providing education related to caring for children with life-limiting illnesses.

The DC Pediatric Palliative Care Collaboration, in collaboration with the VCU Health System's Pediatric Palliative Care Department, is presenting a two-day workshop discussing end-of-life care issues relating to pediatric patients.
