VCU Sports Medicine

Athletes and weekend warriors alike can find help with their injuries at the VCU Sports Medicine outpatient clinic. The sports medicine team provides comprehensive care, helping patients regain and maintain active participation in sports, recreational activities and job tasks.

The outpatient clinic features an array of services, including preparation and training of athletes, injury prevention, extensive diagnostic services, radiology services, physical and aquatic therapy and long-term rehabilitation.

The clinic not only treats athletes and weekend warriors, it also helps individuals with orthopaedic injuries who have hurt themselves at work, at home or at play. Staffed by a multidisciplinary team of physicians and specialists, VCU Sports Medicine diagnoses a wide range of injuries using expertise and specialized tools, including MRI, CT and bone scans.

VCU Sports Medicine provides care at its 1300 West Broad Street location, located just next to the Siegel Center on the VCU Monroe Park Campus.

About VCU Gold

The VCU Medical Center offers two unique benefits to VCU and VCU Health System employees. VCU Gold provides "Fast Track" ambulatory care scheduling at our specialty clinics for new patient appointments, usually within two weeks for routine visits and 48 hours for an urgent visit. The Open Access program provides primary health care for the whole family through the Departments of Family Medicine and Pediatrics.

Appointments

To schedule a new patient appointment at the VCU Medical Center, simply call 628-3627 and identify yourself as a VCU or VCU Health System employee or family member. If a routine or urgent visit is not possible within a satisfactory time frame, a patient advocate is available at 628-3627 to assist with scheduling the appointment. If you are a returning patient and need assistance, the patient advocate is there to help.

Locations

Ambulatory care services consist of specialty clinics on the MCV Campus and locations in surrounding communities, including Stony Point, the West End, South Richmond and Hanover County. A free shuttle is available from the Monroe Park Campus to the MCV Campus. Valet parking (\$5) is also available.
