I. Call to order

In accordance with Virginia Freedom of Information Act, Section 2.2-3708.2 "Meetings held through electronic means", Subsection G., this meeting of Representatives of the VCU Health System ("VCUHS") Board of Directors was held via a Zoom and livestreamed. He stated VCUHS has been a leader in COVID response and, as a political subdivision of the state, is a great partner to the Commonwealth.
