I. Call to order

Dr. Rao, Chair VCU Health System Board of Directors and Mr. Parker, Rector, VCU Board of Visitors called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m. Ms. Gray and Ms. Tacconi conducted a roll call to see who was present. In accordance with Virginia Freedom of Information Act, Section 2.2-3708.2 "Meetings held through electronic means", Subsection G., the meeting was held by electronic

communication means via Zoom. The public was able to view the open session of the meeting via livestream at <u>https://mssvideo.vcu.edu/BOV</u>.

II. <u>Report of the President and Chair</u>

Dr. Rao began his report of the President and Chair by expressing gratitude to both boards for their support, dedication through the many challenges of the past year. He noted that VCU and VCU Health System are emerging stronger, together in support of their complex mission. Dr. Rao spoke about the joint meeting noting the last time the group was together they approved the appointment of Dr. Kellermann. He continued that Dr. Kellermann's arrival is symbolic of the coming transformation for student and patient access and outcomes. Dr. Rao noted that the social changes are harder to see. He stated that VCU and VCUHS have been integral to the response to the COVID pandemic. He highlighted the areas including providing access to patients and students, communication and leveraging expertise of epidemiologists, pathologists among others. He stressed that VCU and VCUHS are dedicated to inclusivity for student and patient access. Dr. Rao also spoke about other areas of transformation including clinical trials and Massey Cancer Center. He noted that he hopes this meeting will provide a forum increase the Board of Visitors engagement in Health System information beyond the five overlapping board members. Dr. Rao reported that VCU Health System has been recognized as #1 hospital in the region as well as being top decile in experience, quality and safety performance for Anthem Q-HIP. He then spoke about the clinical alignment and focusing on the clinical delivery system to advance treatment and cures. He also noted that social determinants are a

significant factor in health and they need to be a greater focus. Dr. Rao concluded his remarks, stating that Dr. Kellermann will be speaking about important strategies at VCU Health System.

III. Public Comment

Ms. Chelsea Gray, Assistant Secretary and Board Liaison of the VCU Board of Visitors, reminded the Boards that written comments concerning the proposed agenda items were able to be submitted prior to the meeting via an online portal and VCU board email. She noted there were no comments submitted. The public was also notified that there would be a public comment session at this meeting however no one pre-registered to speak. Ms. Tacconi, Assistant Secretary and Board Administrator for VCU Health System Board of Directors, also advised there were no public comments received for VCU Health System.
