## Digital Mammography

We now offer the latest technology in women's breast imaging, digital mammography. Digital mammography provides precise and detailed images, which means quicker results since there is no film to develop. The images can be viewed instantly and transferred electronically to the radiologist, reducing wait time for you and your doctor to receive test results.

- Screening mammography - consist of two views of each breast in patients who have no abnormal breast symptoms.
- Diagnostic mammography - for patients with abnormal breast symptoms or who had a screening mammogram reveal a breast abnormality or suspicion. Also for patients who have breast implants.

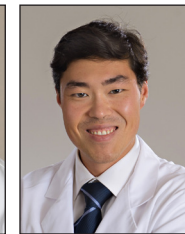

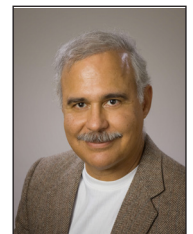
